Approved City of the Future Project Sequencing

After reviewing the sequencing of projects in the 2002 Facilities Study, considering the timeframe from Educational Specification development to construction, and factoring in the focus of the recommendations was to address overcrowding in Southside the following sequencing of projects is approved by the School Board. Realizing that several projects may be accomplished at the same time the list does not reflect a pure sequence, but rather a ranking of projects for the entire period of the City of the Future Plan of 2007-2011. Actual start dates for construction and renovation will be driven by the availability of money under the City of the Future Plan.

1. New or renovated existing commercial site for the Capital City Program (Alternative School)
2. New Broadrock Elementary
3. New E.S.H Greene Elementary
4. New Swansboro Elementary
5. New Elkhart Middle School
6. New Huguenot High School
7. New George Mason Elementary
8. Renovate MLK envisioned as a K-8 model
9. New Fulton area Elementary
10. New Woodville Elementary School
11. Renovate Oak Grove Elementary
12. Holton Addition for Thirteen Acres Students
13. New Northside Elementary(Overby-Sheppard, Norrell)
14. New campus style high school on the Maymont Site (Open HS, Richmond Community HS, Specialty HS, REAL School)
15. Addition at Amelia Street for Pre-school Programs

Since the PPEA efforts to provide a new building for the Capital City Program have been unsuccessful to date, the building for the CCP program has been added at the top of the list as the School Board's number one priority.
